A professor in the 1990s, then General Secretary of various departments at Cnam (Paris), she helped create the first public-private economic interest grouping (GIE) bringing together Cnam, PSA and Renault in 2000.

In 2007, she became head of the Cifre department at the ANRT and developed international programmes with Brazil and Morocco.

In 2011, she set up an annual competition to encourage Cifre doctoral students to create their own company. This competition was also organised in Australia (2016, 2017) and India (2017).

In 2016, she became the first woman to head the ANRT since its creation in 1953. Her mission is to serve the French research community by sharing strategic visions and federating public and private ecosystems.
