Retired Major General (Air Force) Albert Husniaux is a Master of Science in Engineering (1980), specialized in mechanics, ballistics, aeronautics and astronautics and holds associate degrees in telecommunications (networks) (2018) and computer science (networks) (2019).

He has been the first NATO Chief Scientist from 1 July 2012 to 1 October 2016, also chairing the Board of NATO's Science and Technology Organization.

Retired Major General Husniaux has both a scientific background (Physics and Science and Technology management) and a military officer's background. The common threads in his multidisciplinary career are aerospace, innovation, change management and science and technology.

He has been awarded the 2016 Engineering Manager of the Year Award of the American Society of Engineering Management and has been granted an Honorary Doctorate by the Polytechnic University of Bucharest (Romania) on July 7, 2017.
