Jean-Pierre Raskin, graduated M. Sc., and Ph. D. degrees in applied sciences, from the Université catholique de Louvain (UCLouvain), Belgium, in 1994 and 1997, respectively. In 1998, he made a post-doctoral stay of two years at The University of Michigan, Ann Arbor, USA. In 2000, he joined the Microwave Laboratory of UCLouvain, as Associate Professor, and he has been a Full Professor since 2007. He received several international awards in recognition in his vision and pioneering work in the field of Radio Frequency microelectronics. In 2017 and 2022, he received the European Global Education Innovation Award and a European Triple E Award for the course-project *IngénieuxSud*.
