

Maja Schlüter is a Professor of Social-ecological Systems Science at the Stockholm Resilience Centre at Stockholm University. Her research focuses on theorizing processes of adaptive and transformative change or lack thereof in marine and agricultural systems, with a particular emphasis on the challenges of complex causality and social-ecological interdependencies. She is also interested in developing the conceptual and methodological foundations of studying complex social-ecological systems, and in applying process-relational philosophies to thinking and studying SES differently. She leads an interdisciplinary team at Stockholm Resilience Centre that spans the natural and social sciences and humanities, funded among others by an ERC advanced grant for the project TransMod.
