YASAS – What, How and Why?

Young Academies Science Advice Structure (YASAS): to include young academies in Europe as a part of the Science Advice for Policy by European Academies (SAPEA) and SAM mechanism






Process:

- Discussions since late 2018
- Summer 2020 – preparation of statutes (approx. 10 academies involved)
- December 2020 - statutes signed – currently 16 members (out of 22 eligible): Belgium, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, Germany, Hungary, Lithuania the Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Romania, Scotland, Spain, Sweden, YAE, GYA
- May 2022 – beginning of SAPEA+ (consortium agreement signed)

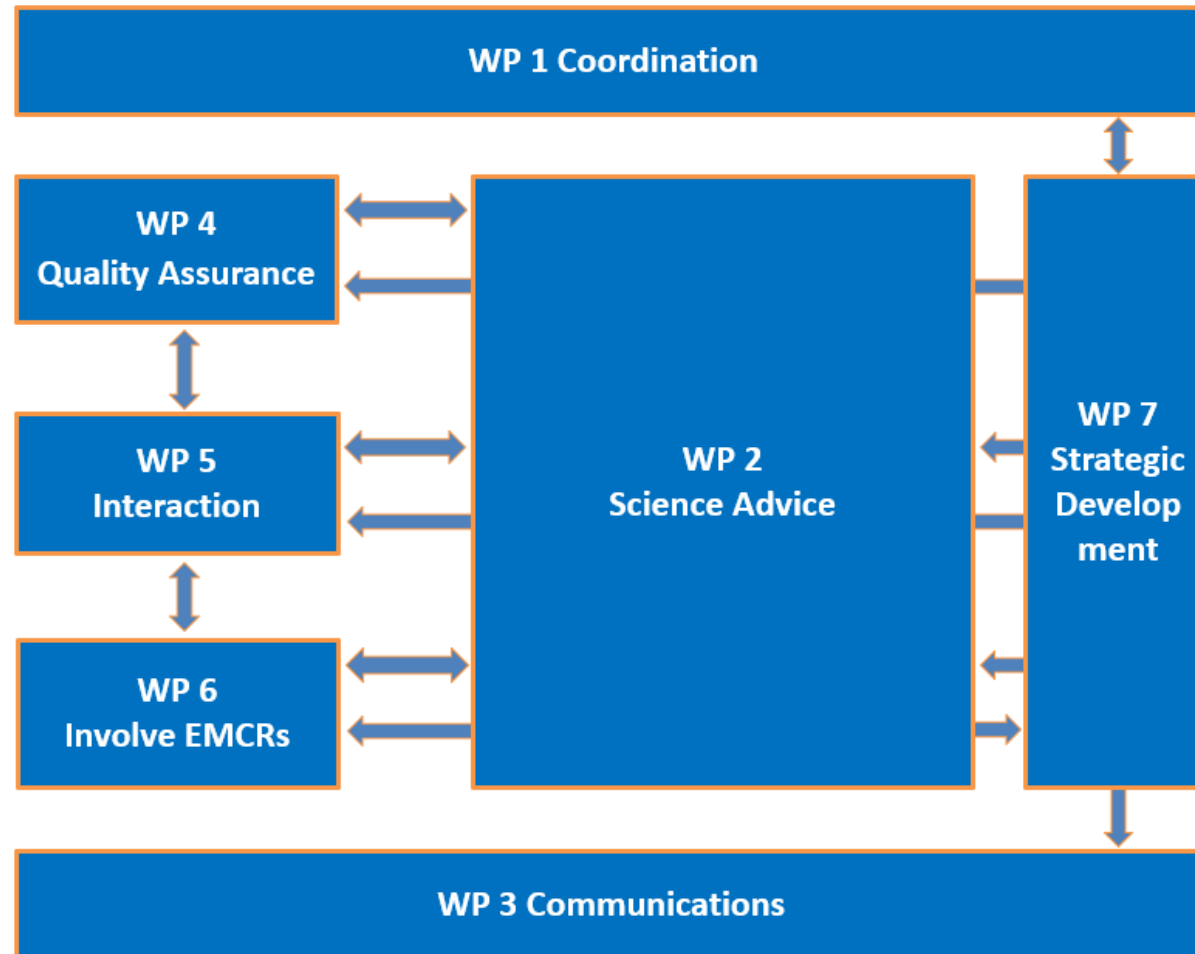

YASAS Work Package 6 -> EMCR for SAPEA+

Objectives & Background

- improve the involvement of Early- and Mid-Career Researchers (EMCR) in the activities of SAPEA and the Scientific Advice Mechanism
- build a strategic network of EMCR organisation
- identify hurdles as well as incentives for EMCR to participate
- maintain and expand the YASAS network to other young academies

Work plan

- Initial Strategy to involve more EMCRs in SAPEA activities – OCTOBER 2022
 - Evaluate what has been done so far in SAPEA in terms of EMCRs involvement (using already existing data)
 - Map a network of relevant EMCR organisations and plan the collaboration
 - Plan / propose targets for SAPEA, plan implementation and monitoring
- Report on hurdles for EMCRs to engage in science advice for policy activities – AUGUST 2023
 - Identify obstacles for participation (execute comprehensive survey + collect best practices + lit research)
- Prepare full strategy and implement it
